I have some trouble with this. That's my own problem, my own resistance to questionnaires. But also, how do you put a father, a mother, a sister, let alone a son or wife of over twenty years into a selective bag of memories? Mom loved the ocean, Pop worked hard and gave it great dignity? What they all give is as complex, comic, infinite, tragic, and simple as life. I have trouble leaving that much out.

I will say one thing stands out tonight, July 8, 1991. I was fortunate enough to have time to visit occasionally—almost regularly—with Gramma Foss when I was 22-23 years old, 1970-71. I only lived a couple of blocks away, was just out of college, working part time. I had no excuse. And, of course, she was wise and she was interested, an awesome combination in a sack of bones. It was a time in my life when I held confusion like a walking stick. I didn't know who I was or what I wanted to do. She asked questions. We talked about how the world was then. She didn't make judgments. She was interested, and had the time to consider what she observed. One day she said, "Joanie is a very strong person." Joanie was only 19, and I had not seen that, had not thought of her in those terms before. Who knows the small things, the casual conversations that make a difference?
