2014 Sandwich Fair Report

It was a test to see if the Sandwich Fair was worth a second try. The Sandwich Fair has been around since 1888 and is the 2nd largest fair in Illinois. Only the State Fair in Springfield is larger. To boost interest in our booth, a special card was sent to 5,000 names in the Oswego and Yorkville, IL communities. It's hard to know how many visitors to our booth received a card, but some mentioned receiving the card in the mail and I thought there was more traffic and interest than last year. People remembered us from last year and mentioned having picked up items from our booth. In spite of the rain and extreme heat, each shift of the fair had opportunities for witnessing and blessings.

We used the basic approach that was used at the Indiana State Fair with the APP card and How to Study the Bible booklet as the main FREE offer to visitors. We also had a small cargo trailer parked nearby so we could keep supplies to a useful, uncluttered number and replenish as needed. New faces in the staff included Br. Roland Osipov (Canada), Sr. Lyn York (Michigan), Br. Dan Larson (Chicago), Br. Jack and Sr. Donna Whittaker (Chicago), and Br. Seth Kopak (new in Chicago). We certainly don't want to forget little Julia Hosu and Marcus. It brings back memories of when my mom would bring Alys and me to service meetings and tracting. Thank you Sr. Patricia.

I appreciated that Srs. Alina and Veronica (both also new in Chicago) served on Sunday. It would have been a long day without their help. It was good to get to know Seth better and have his help in the teardown stage.

There were a variety of challenges. Some included the rain, heat, and humidity. Other challenges came from witnessing experiences or even the lack thereof. Everyday ended with the question, "How did you handle today's challenge?" Brethren were motivated to find better answers or study the subject for better understanding. That is good. There are just so many subjects to remember how to explain them. Witnessing helps dust off the grey cells of the brain.

Seth and Alina met Howard. He had questions on the 70 years prophecy. (You **never** know what subject is coming up next!) It was interesting. We had just discussed this before Howard came up. I wasn't there for the discussion with Howard and I'm glad. Everyone needs these experiences to struggle through on their own. It's a great motivation to study a subject. I'm sure they were motivated after Howard left! Later in the day, Howard came back. He jumped around spouting various dates... 1844, 1914, 1972, etc. He wasn't looking for answers as much as testing to see what we knew. 
